Background:

As there are several municipal drains in various stages of progression, this is an update on their activity.

Comments:

MacIntyre Municipal Drain- Contractor moved onsite the last week of June and has commenced brushing to establish the working corridor. He is working from top to bottom and then he will start the actual drain construction.

Park Street Municipal Drain- Second information meeting scheduled for July 15 using the zoom platform for members of the watershed. Preliminary costs and assessment schedules will be presented along with the scope of the proposed work. Allowing for feedback and finalization of details, the report should come to Council before year-end. The details to participate electronically are posted to the municipal calendar.

Bruce Beach Municipal Drain- Road survey completed, although drawings have not been received by the Engineer yet. Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority is providing more rainfall data to help with modeling for the gully above 98 Bruce beach. Decision to retain outlet at 98 Bruce Beach or choose an alternate is being evaluated.

Emerson- Final information meeting is coming in July. If restrictions are relaxed sufficiently then an in person meeting or else a virtual setup.

Robert MacDonald- Setting up an initial site meeting in July. This is to extend the existing closed drain further downstream.

Von Hovel- Setting up the initial site meeting in July. This is to provide a legal outlet for tile drainage across Lake Range Drive north of Con. 10.
